# SASI CANOE SPRINT

## 2011 squad selection process

The information below is the selection process, which will be used to select the SASI Canoe Sprint Scholarship Holders for 2011.

### Pre Selected Athletes

**Platinum level scholarship** – Only athletes who have won an Olympic medal at the previous Olympic Games or a recent Senior World Championship medal in Olympic class events will be considered for this level of scholarship. Eligible athletes in 2011 are **Hannah Davis and Luke Morrison** these athletes must meet one of the following standards at either the SASI qualification time trial Nov. 28<sup>th</sup> 2010 or GP#1 Dec. 3-5 2010 to gain a Platinum level scholarship for the 2011 SASI scholarship period.

*Time Trial requirement – Achieve Gold Standard result.*

*or*

*GP#1 – top 3 in any K1 Olympic distance event or win K2 in any K2 Olympic distance event.*

### Prognostic time trial selection requirement for non Pre Selected Athletes

(one trial only – Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> November Start time 10am)

The following time trials will be used to calculate each athletes best individual prognostic score which is the athletes time given as a percentage against a calculated average of the best 3 times in the world in each distance 2004-2008 inc. these times can be found on the International Canoe Federation Web site. (Distances and calculated average times listed below)

| Event<br>(New Olympic K1 events) | Calculated 100% prognostic time = Average of 3 worlds<br>best times 2004-2008 inc. |
|----------------------------------|--|
| K1 200m                          | 34.84  |
| K1 1000m                         | 3:25.09  |
| WK1 200m                         | 40.00  |
| WK1 500m                         | 1:48.57  |

Following the time trial each athlete will receive a prognostic % score for each distance (athletes may race both distances but only their highest % score will be used) their individual highest % score will then be used as their individual prognostic ranking score – this prognostic percentage will then be compared to the best in the squad (**not to the best in the world**)

The 2011 SASI Canoe Sprint Squad selection policy will also include a review process for all current 2010 scholarship athletes. A 2011 scholarship will be conditional on the athlete completing an individual training and performance agreement. The athlete will then be offered an appropriate level of scholarship based on all relevant information.

*Athletes may be added as associate scholarship holders or promoted to become full scholarship holders at any time or following National GP regattas, National selection trials or National Championships based on the level of performance achieved, previous National and International performances may also be taken into consideration. Inclusion to the squad will be at the discretion SASI Coaches and SASI Management.*
