### EXAMPLE ONE

**Organisation:** Sturt Badminton Club

**Target Group:** Youth and mature aged hearing impaired including their families

**Partnerships:** Parents of Hearing Impaired South Australia (PHISA)

**Barriers:** Communication  
Access to equipment/coaching  
Lack of confidence  
Fear of injury  
Scheduling

**Program:** **Hearing Impaired Hit Up Program**  
The aim of this program is to assist young and mature aged hearing impaired in the Adelaide metropolitan area become more physically active by encouraging participation in the sport of badminton through positive interaction and coaching supported with appropriate communication strategies.

**Barriers Addressed:** **Communication**  
PHISA to provide “communication training” to club coaches.

**Access to equipment/coaching**  
The grant will cover equipment, venue hire and coaching fees.

**Lack of confidence**  
The program is designed to support participants from a range of different age groups in a social environment therefore increasing confidence.

**Fear of injury**  
The activity is non-contact and a trained instructor decreases the risk of injury.

**Scheduling**  
Weekend and school holiday clinics were determined to be an ideal time as hearing impaired participants are less likely to be fatigued compared to an after school activity/session.
