

SASI Sailors Qualify for World Championships

SASI Sailing scholarship holders **Dylan Clarke** and **Shane Hughes** in have qualified for an entry in the 470 Class at the 2007 ISAF Sailing World Championships in Cascais, Portugal from their results in the 2005 and 2006 470 Class World Championships. Australia has a very limited entry into this event and is a great result for sailing in South Australia. In the RSX windsurfing class, SASI coach **Brendan Todd** has also qualified in one of only two entry's in this event.

SASI Sailing scholarship holder **Andrew Hughes** has just completed an intensive training camp in Sydney with national class coach **Lars Kleppich**. Twelve RSX sailors were in attendance from five states. This was by far the best and most comprehensive training camp for RSX class this year.

South Australia has secured the RSX Olympic windsurfing class national championships for 2008. This championship will be held in Adelaide over the March long weekend.
