Fifteen-year-old Georgia Minear returned home from a long weekend of competition in Melbourne to learn that she had been added to the Under 19 Australian Gems team that departs on a two week tour of France on Monday June 16.

The team will compete in two international tournaments during their stay in France.

It is the first of two tours the Gems will have in the build-up to the Oceania qualifiers (in Adelaide in August) for the 2009 World Junior Championships.

Georgia joins three other SA girls in the team, AIS Scholarship holders Kelsey Ireland, Bree Farley and Tess Madgen.

Her selection is well deserved following a number of good performances at Australian Development and Gems camps.

She will return home just in time to join her Under 18 state metro teammates for the National Championships in Ballarat next month.
