### K4 1000M - SILVER

This is the best performance ever by an Australian Men's K4 to date, both in terms of time and placing, at a World Championship or Olympics. They have qualified Australia to race this event at the Olympics with their performance. Germany won in a World Record Time - 2:47.7. Australia would also have been under World Record Time if the Germans were not in front - 2:48.7.

50% of this crew (Tate & David) raced this event at Beijing - which is great for depth of experience leading into next year's Olympics.

### WK4 500M - 5TH

This is a brand new crew for this year which is very promising! They have qualified Australia to race this event at the Olympics with their performance.

50% of this crew (Hannah & Lyndsie) were bronze medalists in this event at Beijing - which is great for depth of experience leading into next year's Olympics.

### WK1 200M A FINAL - 4TH & 5TH

Alana's first World Championships paddling K1, and she came away with two top 5 placings! These results hold huge promise leading into next year's Olympics.
